For your topic homework this half-term, we would like you to make a poster for Science Week. The theme this year is 'Time'. Here are some ideas for your poster:

- How has a certain type of technology changed over time?
- How do clocks work? How has this technology changed over time?
- Time in nature- Lifecycles, growing fruit and vegetables.
- Space and Time. How long does it take to orbit the sun? How long is one rotation on Earth?
- Celebrate 30 years of Science week- what has changed in time in the last 30 years? You could take one type of technology and make a timeline.
