The Earth and beyond

Our learning journey this term is based around the question: Will we ever send another human to the moon? We will be learning about the solar system and how the Earth moves.

There are some homework ideas below, but feel free to think of your own if you would like to. Be as creative as you like! Bring your finished projects in to school on Monday 4th December.

- English-Write a diary entry as if you are an astronaut visiting the moon.
- English-Write a fact file/ poster about the different planets in the Solar System.
- English- Write a news article about a moon landing.
- Art/ DT- Design and create a model rocket ship.
- Art/ DT Make your own model of a planet. Write a list of facts to go with it.
- History- Find out about the first moon landing, who was the first astronaut to land on the moon?
- Science- Find out about Tim Peake. How did he become an astronaut? What did he do on his mission in space? You could write an imaginary interview with him.
- Science- Keep a diary of the moon over several days. How and why does it change shape?
- Science- Record a video of you explaining why we have day and night. Use a ball and torch to show the movement of the Earth.
- Science- Star gazing. Find out about the stars and the constellations. Can you identify any at night?
